



Frequently Asked Questions

All Categories » General - Applies to all BSI Applications BSI Recomended Regular System Maintenance

BSI recommends performing regular system maintenance on your computers running BSI products. For most systems once per week is adequate, however the exact frequency that a system will need maintenance will depend highly on the system hardware and usage.

- Run Scan Disk and Defragmenter utilities
- Clear temp folder contents
- Uninstall Programs that are not needed
- Turn off any running processes that are not needed
- Delete the audio.mdb, audio.ldb, and audio.dat files located in C:\BSI32 (All BSI software must be closed to do this)
- Run a full system back-up

If the computer has internet access

- Run a virus scan
- Run Spyware/Adware removal software
- Delete cookies
- Delete temporary internet files

On a Simian System:

- Set up a daily COMPACTHEAP macro to clear up resources
- Set up a daily COMPACTDATABASE macro to maintain the audio.mdb database
- Run the RegSave program available on the BSI website to back-up your Simian settings
